



“CET-INDIA TEST” 2014/15

Common Entrance Test (CET): CET-India is in the interest of Polish Universities to get number of qualified Indian students, especially when Poland is going through huge demographic problems and Polish universities are not able to fulfill their seats through normal admission process. Many Polish universities are struggling for their existence. CET-India can be more reliable to get **proper, competent and qualified students** from Indian regions and improve educational environment at their Institutes by receiving full tuition fees from incoming students.



CET-India will be a platform for unification of Indian students interested to go for higher education to Poland (under Polish Partner Universities) and EU (European Union universities) for the purpose of higher education under Bachelor, Master and PhD courses. Under CET examination, all students from Indian region's seeking admission in Poland at various universities- private/ public or any European partner universities under different faculties; must appear for this test and secure highest points to get their confirmed places at interested universities. By law, on August 31st 2014, CET-India has been launched in India with academic and administrative co-operation with Indian universities and agreed to organize it twice in a year- 1st every 3rd Sunday in the month of July e.g. on **19th July 2015 and December 19th 2015**. CET-India Platform is in the capacity to fulfill all desire of Polish University's to receive well-qualified students to their faculties/departments as well as for the student's to provide them best universities in Poland/EU based on their interest and merits received under CET test.

CET as “Common Entrance Test”- India's 1st examination is going to be held in India on 19th July 2015 at five different Centers/universities in cooperation with following universities:

1. Chanakya National Law University (CNLU), Patna
2. Bharati Vidyapeeth Institute of Management and Research (BVIMR), New Delhi
3. Noorul Islam University, Tuckaly, Kanyakumari, Tamilnadu
4. ASM Group of Institutes, Pune
5. BVP New Law College, Pune

All centers are ready to host minimum 10,000 (ten thousand) students for online examination for every year, where students must appear to receive merit list for further interview and documentation (passports, educational certificates, financial backgrounds, language skills, ability to go abroad etc.).

What is CET-India Test?

CET- “Common Entrance Test” for Indian student's seeking admission in Poland and EU universities at different levels: Admissions for Bachelor Courses, Admissions for Master Courses, Admission for PhD courses.

CET is going to be launched by Indo-European Education Foundation (IEEF), in the interest of all Polish and European partner universities. It'll assure the ability of student's to go for higher education abroad based on Polish and EU standard.

All public and private universities from Poland and EU suppose to take part in this program to get their quality of students from Indian regions to fulfill their seats/ admissions.
